1.	1 October	RTHK covered and provided signal of the Flag-Raising Ceremony and Reception of the National Day to broadcasters.

2.	1 October	RTHK and the Labour and Welfare Bureau jointly launched a “Talent-Wise Recruitment” Award Scheme to recognize model employers who hire people with disabilities, bringing home the message of “physical limitations hinder no talents”, and promoting integration of the able-bodied and the disabled in workplaces. In the variety show Gala Extraordinaire – Stage of Ability (能者舞台非凡夜) (1 X 90’), winners of the Award Scheme’s six grand awards were presented. The variety show also gathered a number of international and local performers with disabilities to perform and to showcase the talents of people with disabilities.
3.	2 – 9 October	Commemorating the Centennial of the 1911 Revolution, Hong Kong Connection (鏗鏘集) produced two one-hour specials on the subject (2 X 60’).
