A. Radio

No.	Date	Items
1.	5 May	Public Affairs Unit produced another round of “Voices From The Hall” (眾言堂), addressing issues such as the public’s aspiration on universal suffrage.
2.	5 May	Radio 5 produced a 13-episode series on savouring the flavours of Chinese Kunqu (細味昆曲).
3.	5 May	Cultural and Education Unit’s “Children Sunday” conducted the HK Children Story Telling Competition Final (「全港兒童故事演講比賽」總決賽).
4.	6 May	Radio 5’s “Smile Family” conducted a sharing session with modern mothers raising children (「現代阿媽點教仔」分享會).

8.	18 May	Chinese Programmes Section will conduct the 24 th International Pop Poll (「第二十四屆國際流行音樂大獎」頒獎禮).
9.	25 May	Public Affairs Unit will join hands with the Hong Kong Red Cross to conduct the Hong Kong Humanity Award Presentation (「香港人道年獎」頒獎禮).
10.	3 June	Radio 5 will conduct a programme reshuffle and introduce new programmes in early June.
11.	4 June	Putonghua Channel will partner with the News Channel of Radio Guangdong (廣東電台新聞台) and Shanghai’s China Business Network (上海第一財經) to conduct the “San Jiang Forum” (三江論壇) hosted in Hong Kong.

1.	May	The new series of “SFC In Action II” (證義搜查線) shows the audience how people are caught by the lure in the “money game” and how the Securities and Futures Commission (SFC) regulates the securities and futures markets in Hong Kong so as to protect the rights of investors in general.
2.	May	“The Moment II” (一念之間 II) raises social awareness on the importance of family core values and family harmony.
3.	May	In the documentary production “Hong Kong Industries 2013” (力創驕陽), viewers are showcased the latest developments in the manufacturing industry of Hong Kong through interviews of personalities from the industry and reviews of successful cases.

8.	May	A new series “Court” (開庭) covers the “Mock Trial Competition Project” organised by The Society of Rehabilitation and Crime Prevention, Hong Kong. By participating in mock trials, students can learn more about the laws and justice system of Hong Kong.
9.	June	In “Excellent Classrooms” (卓越教室), the awardees of the Chief Executive’s Award for Teaching Excellence will share their experiences and enthusiasm in teaching.
10.	June	The new series “All About Money” (原來錢作怪) will continue to introduce economics in daily life.
