

**Updates on Programmes for

A. Radio

No.	Date	Items
1.	29 October – 12 November / 9 November	Public Affairs Unit (PAU) produced a special series for the US Presidential Election. On election day, our news sections produced programmes for results announcement and analysis.
2.	2 November	Culture and Education Unit (CEU) launched a new programme series “Music Research Institute” (音樂研究所) which focused on the history and culture of different music types.
3.	4 November	R2 organised the “OSH Carnival 2016-17 Occupational Safety Slogan Competition Opening Ceremony” (職安POWER 全起動 2016-17 職安健口號創作比賽啟動禮) to advocate the importance of occupational safety to the public.
4.	4 November – 29 December /	Community Involvement Broadcasting Service (CIBS) application for Q17 and Q18 programmes has started. A consultation session will be organised on 11 December.
5.	5 November / 12 November	Putonghua Channel (PTC) conducted the semi-final and final of the “Inter-collegiate Putonghua Debate Competition 2016” (2016 大專普通話辯論賽) on 5 and 12 November respectively..
6.	5 – 6 November	R4 presented the “Music Beyond Borders” concerts which featured artists from Italy.

No.	Date	Items
1.	Starting 3 November 2016	“Caribbean with Simon Reeve”, “Ireland with Simon Reeve”, “Greece with Simon Reeve”, “Simon Reeve’s Sacred Rivers”(型男型旅) (10 episodes x one hour) feature adventure journalist Simon Reeve who embarks on journeys of discovery to Caribbean Sea, Ireland, Greece, the Nile and Yangtze River to get to know the place and people as well as to examine the social issues in these places.
2.	Starting 15 November 2016	“Living Culture” (非常宅) (6 episodes x half hour) is a magazine programme on home maintenance and upkeep as well as on stories relating to our living environment.

3.	Starting 16 November 2016	“Hall of Wisdom” (大學問) (8 episodes x half hour) will cover a series of public lectures co-organised by the General Education Unit, the University of Hong Kong and RTHK with guest speakers such as Sarah Lee, Rex Tso, Jasper Tsang Yok-sing, Joseph Yam Chi-kong, and etc.
4.	Starting 16 November 2016	The third season of “Money World” (金錢國度3) (13 episodes x one hour) continues to study the influence of money to the societies from different perspectives.
5.	Starting 26 November 2016	“68th Hong Kong School Music Festival” (第 68 屆學校音樂節優勝者匯演) (8 episodes x one hour) will present highlights of the winners’ performances, including individual and group performances by primary and secondary school students. Besides classical music and songs, Chinese opera is also included in this year’s programme.
6.	27 November 2016	The magazine programme, “Silvermine Bay Music Festival 2016” (銀礦灣沙灘音樂節 2016) (1 episode x one hour) features the Silvermine Bay Music Festival which is an annual event held on Lantau Island for the local pop bands and music lovers to share their passion for music.
7.	Starting 28 November 2016	“We Are Good Neighbours - Children Show” (Harry 哥哥好鄰居) (130 episodes x 15 minutes) is a magazine programme for children with magic performances, singing and playing games with children, etc.
8.	Starting 3 December 2016	The documentary “Hong Kong Stories” (香港故事-本土 plus+) (10 episodes x half hour) features the development of Hong Kong, the process of how every façade of Hong Kong is transforming and renewing itself into new possibilities.
9.	Starting 4 December 2016	“Outstanding Chinese Writers II” (華人作家 II) (6 episodes x one hour) depicts the contributions and social impacts of the Chinese writers in our society.
10.	Starting 10 December 2016	The magazine programme, “Running Hong Kong” (有一種信念，叫跑！) (暫名) (4 episodes x half hour), covers different aspects of running, its skills and impacts on physical, mental and emotional health, personal growth, etc.
11.	22 December 2016	“Year Ender 2016: Hong Kong Political Affairs” (2016 香港政情大事回顧) (1 episode x half hour) will review major local news events in the year.
12.	24 December 2016	“A Kylie Christmas at the Royal Albert Hall” (Kylie Minogue 聖誕快樂) (1 episode x 1.5 hours) features Kylie Minogue in concert at the Royal Albert Hall in London, performance of which included many of her greatest hits and Christmas classics.
13.	24 December 2016	“Arts on Air: Christmas Concert in the Park – Christmas Rhapsody” (演藝盛薈: 聖誕園林音樂會 - 聖誕狂想曲) (1 episode x 1.5 hours) is a live broadcast of the Christmas Concert to be held at Kowloon Park on Christmas Eve.
