

## Updates on Programmes for May – June 2017

### A. Radio

No.	Date	Items
1.	1 May	R3 conducted a “Backchat Special” on issues related to 20 years of the HKSAR.
2.	5 May	R2 organized the “28 <sup>th</sup> International Pop Poll” (第二十八屆國際流行音樂大獎) at Sha Tin Government Secondary School.
3.	5 May – 15 September	As one of the 20 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the HKSAR Government initiatives, R5 produced a special 20-episode series “Stand by Me – Colourful Hong Kong” (有你同行：香港·情) to interview a group of elderlies of different nationalities and ethnicities who have lived in Hong Kong for a long period of time.
4.	11 May 14 / 18 May – 3 Jun / 21 May	Q19 and Q20 of the Community Involvement Broadcasting Service (CIBS) were open for application. A series of promotion were held in May to promote the services, including “CIBS Days”, “CIBS Express” and “CIBS Expo”. Programme representatives of Q16 were invited to share their experiences.
5.	14 May / 11 June	The Culture & Education Unit (CEU), co-organized with the Boys’ and Girls’ Clubs Association of Hong Kong, launched the semi-final of the “Children’s Storytelling Competition” (兒童故事演講比賽) in May. The grand final will be held in June.
6.	17 May	R1 arranged a press visit for the recording of “Hong Kong Story Radio Drama” (香港故事廣播劇). This new series of radio drama will be produced depicting how Hong Kong society has changed in the past 20 years.
7.	23 May	R5, co-organized with the World Vision and Hong Kong Baptist Hospital Au Shue Hung Health Centre, produced a charity show “The Elderly 8-Hour Famine Concert” (耆英饑饉八小時香江暖流凝絃愛音樂會) to donate for the education and protection of children’s projects for Syrian refugees.
8.	28 May	R1 will organize an activity for the “World No Tobacco Day 2017” (世界無煙日 2017) to support the works on tobacco control and to promote public health.
9.	29 May / 1 June	R4’s RTHK Quartet will present its homecoming concert at Broadcasting House Studio 1 after two school visits in late May. “New Generation 2017” will be held in June to provide opportunities for young Hong Kong composers in creating new works to be performed by professional musicians.

No.	Date	Items
10.	19 June – 14 July	A “Sound File Special” (聲音檔案回歸特輯), with historical sound bites from the past 20 years marking the 20 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the HKSAR Government, will be aired on R1.
11.	24 June	To kick off the “Solar Project 2017”, R2 will organize a concert “同行抗毒當自強” to deliver the anti-drug message.
12.	26 June	RTHK and the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups will co-produce the “Concert of Ten Thousand Voices”(我要起飛萬人青年音樂會) to celebrate the 20 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the HKSAR Government, which will be live broadcast on R2 and TV31.
13.	27 June	CEU will conduct the presentation ceremony of the “10 <sup>th</sup> Hong Kong Book Prize” (第十屆香港書獎).

## B. TV Programmes

No.	Date	Items
1.	7, 9, 26, 27 May & 2, 8, 11 June	TV32 has scheduled to broadcast highlights of major international events, including the French Presidential Election and Legislative Election on 7 May and 11 June, the 19 <sup>th</sup> South Korean Presidential Election on 9 May, the 43 <sup>rd</sup> G7 Summit on 26-27 May, the EU-China Business Summit on 2 June and the United Kingdom General Election on 8 June respectively.
2.	8 -10 May	Highlights of the visit of Zhang Dejiang, Chairman of the Standing Committee of the National People’s Congress to Macau were broadcast on TV32.
3.	Starting 11 May	In “Turkey with Simon Reeve”, “Pilgrimage with Simon Reeve” and “Colombia with Simon Reeve” (型男型旅) (6 episodes x 1 hour), the award-winning travel journalist Simon Reeve will journey across different countries to examine their culture and history.
4.	14 -15 May	Highlights of the “Belt and Road Forum”, which was held in Beijing on 14-15 May, were broadcast on TV32.
5.	Starting 17 May	“Transformers 2017” (香港有你) (10 episodes x half hour) serves as a platform for dialogue between outstanding personalities of different generations who are either developed or grew up locally in Hong Kong in the past two decades to mark the 20 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the HKSAR Government.
6.	Starting 22 May	“Big Cities 2017” (大都會 2017) (10 episodes x half hour), a documentary project co-produced by Asia-Pacific Broadcasting Union (ABU), European Broadcast Union (EBU) and Televisão América Latina (TAL), explores how city dwellers seek ways to tackle city issues.

7.	Starting 28 May	“Miru Miru” (Miru Miru 小海獺) (50 episodes x 5 minutes) is a children programme telling the story of a little sea otter.
8.	Starting 30 May	“English Made Easy 2017” (反斗英語) (10 episodes x half hour) encourages the use of English in our daily life.
9.	Starting 13 June	“Young Music Makers 2017” (樂壇新秀 2017) (8 episodes x half hour) provides a platform for budding performers to display their artistry.
10.	Starting 22 June	In “Secret Cities” (3 episodes x 1 hour), art historian Janina Ramirez and art critic Alastair Sooke will reveal the essence of the three cities, Amsterdam, St Petersburg and Barcelona respectively.
