

Updates on Programmes for September – October 2018

A. Radio

No.	Date	Items
1.	27 August – 24 September	CEU has started the online enrolment of “The Speaker English Public Speaking Contest 2019”. Each school can nominate 2 to 4 students to participate by submitting a 1-minute video of their speech about the theme of ‘Wonder’.
2.	1 September / 9 September / 27 October	PAU premiered the TV version of “Invest Era” (投資新世代) in September on TV-31. The presenters attended the outreach campaign “Mobile TV” (港台電視 31 流動電視廳) to promote the new programme. Besides, “Voices from the Hall – Policy Address” (眾言堂 – 施政報告諮詢) was organized in early September. In October, PAU will continue to co-organize with Hong Kong Red Cross to present the Hong Kong Humanity Award (香港人道年獎).
3.	2 September	PTC launched a new programme named “Greater China 2018” (飛越大中華), to be broadcast on every Saturday from September.
4.	4 September	CEU, co-produced with The Hong Kong Institute for Promotion of Chinese Culture (香港中華文化促進中心), introduced a 13-episode series “Etiquette” (諸君有禮) in September. The programme aimed to promote Chinese culture of “Li Yi” (禮儀) to illustrate how our modern life has been influenced by ancient etiquette from various aspects.
5.	8 September / 21 October	R1 conducted the “Occupational Safety and Health Quiz Show 2018” (職安健常識問答比賽 2018) in early September. In October, R1 will join hand with the Hong Kong Organ Transplant Foundation to kick off the “Organ Donation Project” (愛延續啟動禮) to promote and enhance the importance of organ donation.
6.	9 September – 28 October	R3 kicked off the project “Hong Kong’s Top Story 2018” in early September. The theme of this year was the “Sounds of Hong Kong”. For promoting the latest campaign, the winning pieces of last year have been broadcast from early September to end of October.
7.	15-16 September / 8 October	CIBS conducted the interviews for Q23 and 24 programmes in mid-September. The new programmes of Q22 will be premiered on 8 October with the theme of ‘Social Service’.

8.	20 September / 16 October	Co-organizing with OGCI, R2 conducted the “Info Tour” (資安探訪團) in late September. In October, R2 will have another outreach “ MTR Courtesy Campaign” (港鐵禮貌運動——微行動大力量在乎你) at Tsing Yi Station.
9.	21 September	The press conference of CEU’s “Power of Voice” (聲音的力量) was held at Pui Ching Middle School for the promotion of “Audio Book” and “The Speaker”. Promotional video was rolled out on TV-31 and MINE in early September.
10.	23 September / 13, 20, 27 October	PTC conducted the “Guangzhou-Hong Kong-Macau Inter-Collegiate 1 Putonghua Debate Competition” (粵港澳高校普通話辯論賽) in late September. Besides, three preliminary sessions of “The Inter-collegiate Putonghua Debate Competition” (大專普通話辯論賽) will be held on three consecutive Saturdays in October. 11 colleges has signed up for the competition.
11.	27 September / 22, 31 October	R5 held the “Age-friendly City Interim Sharing Session” (長者友善城市中期成 果分享會) in late September. In October, R5 will organize the “Stand By Me Docent Training and Tour in Tai Po District” (有你同行區區有睇頭 導賞員訓練及導賞遊——大埔區).
12.	1 October	PTC will prepare a 10-episode series of “New Hongkonger Connection” for the 40 th Anniversary of China’s Reform and Opening –up (新紫荊廣場改革開放四十年特備節目——我們的四十年).

1.	1 September	<p>“Robocon 2018” (全港大專生機械人大賽 2018——飛越龍門) (2 episodes x 60 minutes) featured 12 elite teams from five institutions, namely the City University of Hong Kong, the Hong Kong Institute of Vocational Education (Tsing Yi), the Chinese University of Hong Kong, the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, the Hong Kong Polytechnic University and the University of Hong Kong. International Contest (1 episodes x 60 minutes) will be held in Ninh Binh, Vietnam and broadcast on 7 October.</p>
2.	1 September	<p>“Hong Kong Stories” (香港故事——稚說自話) (10 episodes x 30 minutes) tried to look at the world from the eyes of the children.</p>
3.	3 September	<p>TV Division live transmitted “The Ceremony to Commemorate the Victory Day of the Chinese People’s War of Resistance against Japanese Aggression” (中國人民抗日戰爭勝利紀念日儀式) on RTHK TV 32 and provided pool feed signal to the media.</p>
4.	3 September	<p>New round of “830 Magazine” (111 episodes x 60 minutes) would feature on different topics, including travel, movie, sports, current/leisure and pop culture.</p>

5.	4 September	Programmes on different battles would be featured, including “Napoleon Bonaparte, The Egyptian Campaign” (拿破崙埃及之戰) (2 episodes x 60 minutes), “Napoleon - The Russian Campaign” (拿破崙征俄之戰) (2 episodes x 60 minutes), “Waterloo, The Ultimate Battle” (拿破崙滑鐵盧之戰) (1 episode x 60 minutes) and “Apocalypse World War 1” (戰火無情之一戰啟示錄) (5 episodes x 60 minutes).
6.	15 September	“The Pulse Special” (脈搏特輯——土地大辯論) (1 episode x 60 minutes) was an outside broadcast forum organized in Central Pier 10 to discuss the land supply in Hong Kong.
7.	24 September	An archeo-zoologist and safari guide Pauline Crosmarj escorted audience throughout the most exclusive wildlife of Africa in “Safari” (野外自駕遊) (6 episodes x 60 minutes).
8.	30 September	“Indie Music” (硬地音樂 2018) (10 episodes x 60 minutes) will feature the musicians who follow their passion on indie music.
9.	1 October	To celebrate the National Day on 1 October, TV Division will cover and live transmit on TV 32 the Flag Raising Ceremony cum Reception as well as provide pool feed signal to other media. RTHK will also provide pool feed signal for National Day Gala (香港同胞慶祝國慶文藝晚會) and Youth Concert (國慶青年音樂會) on 1 and 2 October respectively.
10.	10-12 October	CE’s Policy Address and related events will be live transmitted on TV32.
11.	13 October	“Elite Brigade IV” (火速救兵 IV) (10 episodes x 30 minutes) will bring out the messages of fire prevention, proper use of emergency ambulance services and the advancement in services of the fire and ambulance professions.
12.	15 October	“We are Good Neighbours III” (Harry 哥哥好鄰居 III) (90 episodes x 15 minutes) is a magazine programme for children with magic performances, singing and playing games with children, etc.
13.	7 & 14 October	Live coverage of “Hong Kong Volleyball Open Marathon” (全港公開馬拉松排球賽) will be live broadcast on TV 32.
14.	21 October	RTHK co-organised with the General Education Unit and the University of Hong Kong to produce “Hall of Wisdom” (大學問) (6 episodes x 30 minutes) which will cover a series of public lectures. Guests will include 梁卓偉, 曾俊華, 林嘉欣, 李澤楷, 林奕華 and 蕭芳芳.

15.	28 October	“Cultural Heritage – The Railroad II” (文化長河鐵道行 II) (6 episodes x 30 minutes) will introduce the newest high speed rail lines, including the Beijing-Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong high-speed railway (京廣深港高鐵) Qingdao-Taiyuan high-speed railway (青太高鐵), Shanghai-Kunming high-speed railway (滬昆高鐵), Harbin-Dalian high-speed railway (哈大高鐵), Lanzhou-Xinjiang high-speed railway (蘭新高鐵) and Hangzhou-Shenzhen high-speed railway (杭深高鐵). With the railway network as our framework, the diversities of different places and the secrets of their intangible cultural heritage items will be shown.
