Updates on Complaints
(Position as at 1.5.2021)

A. Complaints considered by the Communications Authority¹ which have been deliberated by Broadcast Complaints Committee released in March and April 2021

Title	No. of Complaints	Substance of Complaint	Decision
《台灣故事III》	2宗	投訴主要指節目將台灣描繪為「國家」並不準確，以及該節目有欠持平、煽動仇恨中華人民共和國和侮辱國家主權。	<p>通訊局考慮了個案的相關資料，認為：</p> <p>(a) 節目中使用「兩國邦交」和「斷交」詞語，意指台灣是主權國而可與別國建立正式外交關係，有關用語並不準確，明顯違反了《電視節目守則》第9章第1A段要求紀錄片的真實資料須準確無誤的規定；</p> <p>(b) 就有關持平的指稱，由於節目並非有關香港公共政策或備受香港公眾關注而又具爭議性，因此相關條文並不適用；以及</p> <p>(c) 就有關煽動仇恨中華人民共和國和侮辱國家主權的指稱，除上述(a)及(b)段提及的不準確真實資料外，沒有證據顯示港台在節目中加入可能導致任何人士或羣體基於民族、國籍或種族原因而遭人憎恨或畏懼及／或受到污蔑或侮辱。</p> <p>鑑於上述情況，通訊局認為有關節目不準確地使用「兩國邦交」及「斷交」的詞語的投訴成立，港台違反了《電視節目守則》第9章第1A段的規定。經考慮個案的具體事實及情況，以及其他相關因素，通訊局決定向港台發出勸諭，敦促它嚴格遵守《電視節目守則》中的相關條文。</p>
